APPLICATION TO PRACTICE *PRO HAC VICE*

Jacqueline K. Cunningham, Commissioner of Insurance, Bureau of Insurance, State Corporation Commission of the Commonwealth of Virginia, as Deputy Receiver of Southern Title Insurance Corporation (the “Company”), respectfully requests that Andrea L. Bos, Kristen W. Johnson, Joshua O. Lively, Jose M. Rangel (collectively referred to as “Applicants”) be permitted to practice *pro hac vice* in the above-entitled case.

1. On December 20, 2011, the Circuit Court of the City of Richmond entered its Final Order Appointing Receiver for Rehabilitation or Liquidation in which it appointed the State Corporation Commission of the Commonwealth of Virginia (the “Commission”) as the Receiver of the Company.

2. Also on December 20, 2011, the Commission entered its Order Appointing Deputy Receiver for Conservation and Rehabilitation, appointing Jacqueline K. Cunningham, the Commissioner of the Commission’s Bureau of Insurance, as Deputy Receiver (the “Deputy Receiver”).

3. The Applicants are attorneys who represent the Deputy Receiver.

4. All the Applicants are members in good standing of the State Bar of Texas.

5. The Applicants are members in good standing of various bars ranging from the District Courts of the United States to the Circuit Courts of Appeal of the United States.

6. The Applicants are integrally involved in the daily affairs of the Company and the ongoing efforts to develop a workable plan of rehabilitation or liquidation for the Company. Accordingly, the Deputy Receiver requests that the Applicants be admitted to practice before the Commission in order to represent the Deputy Receiver for this case and all cases before the Commission related to the receivership of the Company.


7. The Applicants will abide by all Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Commission and will conduct themselves as other attorneys admitted to practice before the Commission.
